- Ability in drawing on a number of disciplinary origins within areas of the arts, humanities and social sciences to appreciate the richness and the usefulness of interdisciplinary approach.

- Broad-mindedness with ability for critical evaluation;
- Sensitivity toward multicultural communities and be respectful of one another;
